PARENT PAYMENTS POLICY

Dear Parent

Myrniong Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of Myrniong Primary School's parent payment arrangements for 2021.

Myrniong Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents. Below is the breakdown of the charge. These items are essential to support the instruction in the Curriculum that parents and guardians are responsible for, and therefore need to be paid by parents and carers.

Financial Support for Families

Myrniong Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (*eligible if you have a current Health Care Card*) (used towards the cost of camps and/or excursions);
- State Schools Relief (*upon application to the Principal*)
